



THE DREAM OF CREATING THE FIRST SOCIALLY
INTEGRATED FACTORY IN OUR COUNTRY

WE HAVE A CERTAINTY

After a year and a half of permanent garrison, struggle, waits, betrayed hopes and more than eight months of unpaid wages, we have no alternative but to take over the former Gkn factory in cooperative form.

17,000 signatures were collected in less than two weeks to demand public intervention together with people and associations in the area, and we will continue to do so. In the meantime, however, we must be aware that the factory must survive by creating an alternative with the strength of the workers fired and the solidarity movement.

Fundraising campaign

The plan has been launched thanks to the resources raised during the crowdfunding campaign supported by Banca Etica, ARCI and Fridays For Future Italia.

The campaign will be divided into two phases:

1. The first phase, launched in March 2023 on the page of Produzioni dal Basso which **lasted until mid-May 2023** and raised around €175,000 in donations;
2. The next phase will be launched **after the summer of 2023** and will rely on small, medium and large investments from anyone willing to bet on the re-industrialisation plan, investing directly in the coop of the workers. This new phase will be called “azionariato solidale”.

The proposal includes the purchase of a first factory capable of **producing photovoltaic panels and, in a second stage of development, batteries, using a nanolayer printing technique from a proprietary paste** free of lithium, silicon, cobalt, rare earths and heavy metals.

The factory's production start-up takes place within one year after the order is placed. Annual production for the first module (panels) **350,000 KW.**

Total investment costs of the first module production:
27.5 million



The cooperative will allocate an initial package of "Solidarity" shares. This package of shares is addressed to all those, whether individuals or entities, who wish to participate in the solidarity financing of the cooperative, thus becoming part of the assembly of financing members and the Gff project.

CARGOBIKE PROJECT

The cargobike project has the ambition to unite the struggle for the reindustrialization of Gkn with that for sustainable mobility, against exploitation in the urban delivery sector, for ethical delivery to support peasant or small-scale distribution networks.



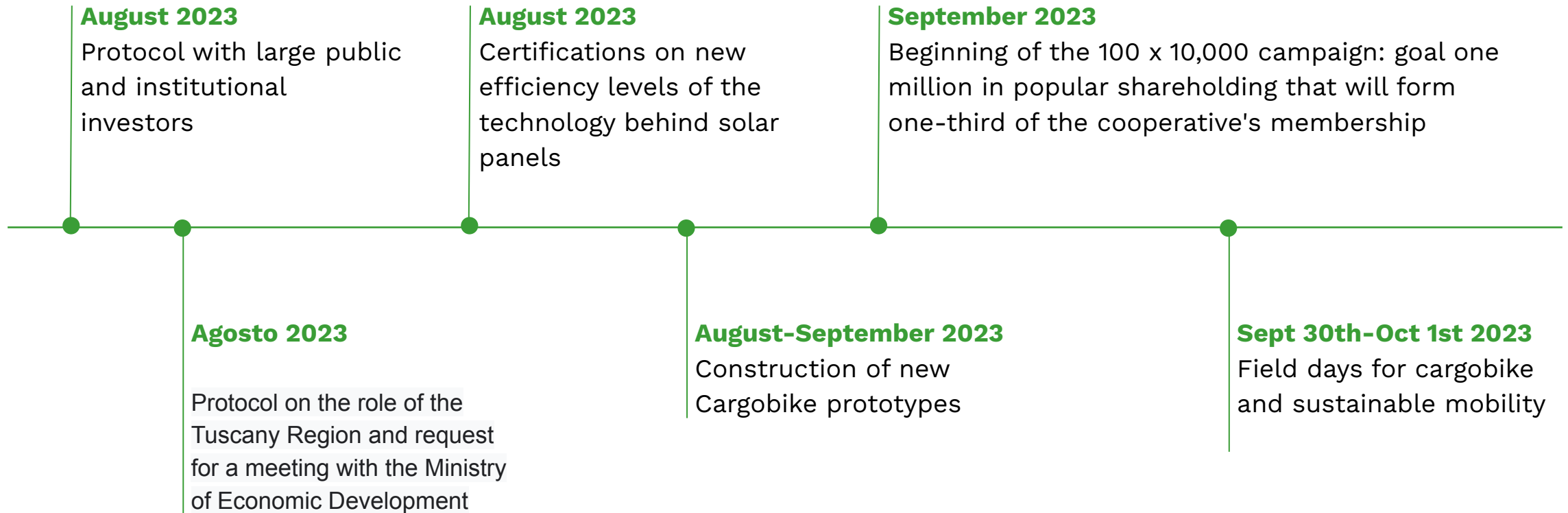
The Factory Collective has developed **three prototype cargo bikes**: one muscle-powered and two electric pedal-assisted (one for cargo loading and one for "domestic" and family use).

The freight-loading prototype is currently being used on the streets of Florence by the ethical delivery cooperative Robin Food. This is enabling the development of a discussion with the entire European ethical delivery federation.

CARGOBIKE PROJECT

The Gff project on the subject of Cargobike has the ambition to become the reference of small Cargo producers, solidarity and self-organized cycle shops, network of struggles for sustainable mobility, actions against exploitation within delivery platforms driven by the blackmail of the algorithm.
